ST. MICHAEL'S PILGRIMAGE TO SCHOENSTATT

On **Saturday**, **August 2**, a group of parishioners from St. Michael made a pilgrimage to Schoenstatt in Waukesha. Schoenstatt is one of several pilgrimage sites in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee for this Jubilee Year.

There is a historical connection between St. Michael and Schoenstatt. The movement's founder, Father Joseph Kentenich, came from Germany to St. Michael Parish in 1951 Milwaukee and served the German-speaking immigrant families there. It is from here that Fr. Kentenich would establish and grow the movement's presence in the United States and establish the current retreat space in Waukesha.

Fun fact, a chapel with the original furniture from the "lower church" of St. Michael (now the hall) is part of the sites to visit in the grounds of Schoenstatt.

⇒ ALL SAINTS FOOD PANTRY


Our Food Pantry is a place where our community can receive groceries at a time of need. We serve more than 500 individuals every month, from several zip codes within Milwaukee's inner city.


GREEN TEAM AT ST. MICHAEL'S

SEASON OF CREATION AND LAUDATO SI'A Time to Rejoice in God's Gift of Creation

In 2015, Pope Francis issued his encyclical, On Care For Our Common Home (Laudato Si'). As we face urgent issues affecting

the common good across nations and neighborhoods, we are called to care for all creation. Pope Francis told us that "Nurturing and cherishing creation is a command God gives not only at the beginning of history, but to each of us. It is part of His plan, it means causing the world to grow responsibly, transforming it so that it may be a garden, a habitable place for everyone." – General Audience, World Environmental Day

Each year from September 1 to October 4, we unite with Christians around the world to celebrate the Season of Creation, a time set apart to reflect, pray and act for the care of our common home. It spans a period of 5 weeks, starting with the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation (September 1) and ending with the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi, patron saint of ecology (October 4). In his lifetime, St. Francis of Assisi achieved harmony with all creation, to the point of calling God's creation, "brother, sister, mother."

This year's theme for the Season of Creation is **Peace With Creation**. The chosen Biblical reference for the initiative is Isaiah 32:14-18.

"Even the palace will be abandoned and the capital city totally deserted. Homes and forts that guarded them will be in ruins forever. Wild donkeys will roam there and sheep will find pasture there. But once more God will send us his spirit. The wasteland will become fertile and fields will produce rich crops. Everywhere in the land righteousness' and justice will be done. Because everyone will do what is right, there will be peace and security forever. God's people will be free from worries and their homes peaceful and safe.

Pope Leo XIV joins Pope Francis in admonishing us: "The mission of safeguarding creation, of bringing peace and reconciliation is the mission the Lord has entrusted to us. We listen to the cry of the earth, we listen to the cry of the poor, because this cry has reached the heart of God. Our indignation is his indignation; our work is his work." Pope Leo reminds us that we are called by our Creator to end the ecological crisis that has as its cause, the breakdown of relationship with God, neighbor and the earth because of sin.

The parish is located in the province of Azua, in the southwest region of the Dominican Republic. La Sagrada Familia covers 124 square miles and serves 19 communities.

To attend to the many needs of the parish, there are various ministries in place to support the community. The various ministries include a health clinic, physical therapy center, three nutritional centers (supporting 180 children), 3 training centers for women, building and repairing houses, water projects, a recycling program, senior ministry/food pantry, after school program, a Pastoral & Social Ministry for the Haitian community, retreat house/eco-lodge and a scholarship program for the youth and young adults.

READING TUTORS NEEDED FOR FALL 2025


